## I AM FULLY VACCINATED TRAVELLING TO NAMIBIA

**ALL** Fully Vaccinated travellers can travel **TO** Namibia with an **original vaccine certificate**.

**NO PCR REQUIRED  
NO UPLOADING TO  
TRUSTED TRAVEL SYSTEM**

**Please Note :**  
**Children (5 and older)** not eligible for vaccination must travel with a negative PCR. Please see details for unvaccinated travellers  
**Children under 5 years** can travel without a PCR Test



## I AM NOT FULLY VACCINATED TRAVELLING TO NAMIBIA

**ALL** unvaccinated travellers age 5 years and older must have a **negative PCR Test** not older than 72-hours upon entry **into Namibia**. Time is calculated from the time the Swab is taken

It is a **mandatory entry requirement** to upload this PCR Test to the **Panabios Trusted Travel System** before boarding for your flight bound to Namibia

**Children under 5-years** can travel without a PCR Test



## I AM FULLY VACCINATED TRAVELLING TO SOUTH AFRICA

All passengers aged 5 years and older traveling **to or transiting through South Africa** with an **original vaccine certificate**

**NO PCR REQUIRED  
NO UPLOADING TO  
TRUSTED TRAVEL SYSTEM**

**Please Note :**  
**Children (5 and older)** not eligible for vaccination must travel with a negative PCR. Please see details for unvaccinated travellers

**Children under 5 years** can travel without a PCR Test



## I AM NOT FULLY VACCINATED TRAVELLING TO SOUTH AFRICA

All passengers aged 5 years and older traveling **to or transiting through South Africa** must hold a negative Covid-19 PCR test certificate. The test must be taken a maximum of 72 hours before departure to South Africa

TRUSTED TRAVEL SYSTEM AS THIS  
IS NOT A REQUIREMENT FOR  
ENTRY INTO SOUTH AFRICA OR  
DEPARTURE FROM NAMIBIA.**
